Outdoor Explorers Beginners

Ensure your child is outside this summer by signing them up to enjoy and learn about the great outdoors! Outdoor activities include: games, obstacle course, making salsa (garden connections), volcanoes/mining for chocolate chips in cookies, fishing, canoeing, terrariums, camping games and animal adaptations/olympics. Your child may take this class 2 years in a row. Most activities will alternate every other year.

Dates and Time: July 3 – 31 on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:30 - 11:30 am

Grades: Completed 2nd – 3rd grade

Place: Cedar Bend Park East Shelter (1267 205th Street, Waverly)

Fee: \$30

Outdoor Explorers Intermediate

This is a longer session to provide more hands-on opportunities. Participants will use a Dutch Oven to bake a wild raspberry cake with raspberries collected from Cedar Bend Park. They will go canoeing, fishing and biking. Activities will also include geocaching, archery, frisbee golf, slacklining, a digital scavenger hunt using cameras, creating a stepping stone and a day at Ingawanis Boy Scout Camp.

Outdoor Explorers Advanced

We plan to kayak the Shell Rock River, bike, shoot archery and geocache at Babcock Woods.

Outdoor Explorer Field Trips

These programs offer half day and day-long opportunities to explore our world. Most essential gear will be provided but participants must bring their OWN LUNCH and drinks, especially water. The Bremer County Naturalist(s) will be present during all trips. All participants must meet at the designated locations. Any child may participate even if they haven't been in Outdoor Explorers before. A detailed timeline and list of items to bring will be mailed out upon receipt of the registration form.

Fly fishing at the Duck Pond in Waverly

Participants will need to be dropped off at the Waverly Duck Pond/Three Rivers Park for this program. Garylee Thurm will be the expert instructor. He will show children the proper technique as well as the proper flies to use. There is a maximum of 10 participants because each child will borrow a fly rod.
