SHOOTING IN AREA OF PENNINGTON STREET AND 17th AVENUE PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JANUARY 19, 2020

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 7:56 a.m. on January 19, 2020, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to the area of Pennington Street and Park Avenue on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival police located a 35-year-old male Paterson resident who was already being treated by EMS for a non-fatal gunshot wound. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment. A potential crime scene was located in the area of Pennington Street and 17th Avenue.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
